“Competent Supervisors: Imprisonment or Liberation?”

St. Mary’s University College, Twickenham

With the best intentions in the world, our liberations can become our prisons. We set up structures and supports to help – we need to ensure that, over time that they don’t result in losing our freedom. This can happen with supervision. Supervision is beneficial in a number of ways and to the various stakeholders involved: clients, practitioners, organisations and the professions. It is hoped that it brings new insight, new learning and new developments that support individuals, teams and organisations grow and do their work better. But could it also restrict us? By making supervision mandatory could we make it artificial and a box-to-be-ticked rather than an exciting review of work? Is it possible that supervisees would hide their work from supervisors and defeat the very purpose of supervision? Perhaps our age of regulation mitigates against the very quality we seek and reduces our effectiveness rather than increase it. This Conference will struggle with that debate: does supervision constrict us or does it liberate us?

Keynotes will occupy the morning of each day. There will be an opportunity after each keynote, for the audience to have a brief discussion and put questions to the speakers. There will be a place for more formal discussion of keynote content in small groups followed by dialogue with keynote presenters on both Saturday and Sunday afternoons. Both days will offer workshop choices after the discussions.
